Introduction

Macedonia International University Medical Coding Curriculum prepares students to be Certified Professional Coders through the American Academy of Professional Coders, or AAPC, which is the gold standard in medical coding.

This is an international certification. Some of the countries which have this certification are the United States of America, Bahamas, Jamaica, Canada, Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Egypt, Kuwait, Pakistan, Brazil, Japan, Ireland, South Africa, and Israel

This program includes three codebooks and a Study Guide Training Manual.

- 1. 2024 ICD-10-CM Expert edition, published by AAPC, to code medical problems or diagnosis.
- 2. CPT 2024 Professional edition, published by American Medical Association, to code medical procedures.
- 3. 2024 HCPCS II Expert edition, published by AAPC, to code medications and other purchases.
- 4. 2024 AAPC Training Manual for the CPC examination.

PLEASE NOTE: The four books are included in MIU Medical Coding program cost and will be given to the student upon the completion of their registration.

The Complete Program

1. The duration of the program is between 16 to 20 weeks.

Upon completion of the training students will be ready to take the certification examination.

This program will include:

2. Compliance and Regulatory Topics (e.g.: the different sections of the Medicare

- a. Human Anatomy and Physiology (Anatomy structure of the body, Physiology how the body functions)
- b. Medical Terminology (the language of medicine how medical professionals refer to problems of their patients, for example: arthritis: 'arthr- 'means 'joint,' and '-itis' means 'inflammation of.'
- c. Medical Coding (translating documentation of patients' medical problems (diagnoses), medical purchases into alphanumeric codes, and medical procedures into five-digit numeric codes.

Proper knowledge and application of appropriate coding guidelines are necessary for coding accuracy and completeness.

- a. Medical problem, for example: diabetes type 2, will be coded as E11.9. (ICD-10-CM book)
- b. Medical procedures, for example, Cardiopulmonary resuscitation or CPR, will be coded as, 92950. (CPT book)
- c. Medical purchases, for example, insulin 5 IU (international units) administered subcutaneously (through the skin with a needle), will be coded as, J1815.
- d. Bath/shower chair, any size, will be coded as E0240. (HCPCS II book).

Examination preparation techniques will be completed within the last two weeks of the program.

Refresher Program

A refresher program of four weeks will also be offered for students who have failed this exam in the past and needs to prepare for it again.

PLEASE NOTE: Both programs will be electronic on Zoom. We may offer both day and evening sessions based on the number of students who have registered.

The day session will be a shorter span of weeks than the evening session because the period of the evening class session will be longer.
